

- Sign the application. If only one parent has full legal custody, only that parent's signature is necessary. Otherwise, both parents' signatures are required. Legally separated or divorced parents will need to send a copy of the final agreement regarding custody.
- Request an official copy of grades (showing the last two full years' work plus the current year's) and the most recent standardized test scores for the applicant.
- Hand out three reference forms – there are 2 kinds, an academic reference and a general reference. Please hand out 1 academic reference to a teacher who knows you well. Please hand out 1 general reference, and then 1 more to a person of your choice.
